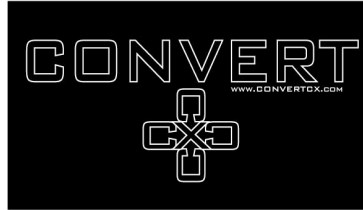

DIRECTIONS: Lake Casitas Recreation Area, Ventura, CA From 101 in Ventura, take HWY 33 toward Ojai. Take left at HWY 150, toward Santa Barbara. Turn left on Santa Ana Road, drive past main entrance. Parking entrance is on the right.

THE COURSE: The 1.9 mile Convert CX course consists of a blend of road, grass, and dirt conditions. Many tight turns, off camber corners, high-speed turns, multiple dismounts, await the riders, all in view of beautiful Lake Casitas. An attempt to blend together Providence RI bowls with Kansas City KS off camber corners, creates a difficult course that allows riders to have some fun at the same time.

THE VENUE: Lake Casitas Recreation Area is a beautiful venue located in Ventura, CA. It is nestled in the rolling foothills of the Los Padres National Forest. The location offers a variety of amenities for families as well as providing an exciting venue for a cyclocross race. Many participants have noted this as one of the best courses in Southern California, as well as one of the most scenic venues.

PARKING: Lake Casitas Recreation Area charges \$10 for parking. We will have our own for \$5.

REGISTRATION: Save \$\$\$, save time and pre-register on-line at <http://sportsbaseonline.com/events/index.shtml?categoryId=11537&dir=left&conversationId=13123>
Series discount passes available at Sportsbase Online. Go to: www.SoCalCross.org and click on the registration link. Each time you pre-register, you will be automatically entered to win a Fuji CX frame and Fork! Online registration closes Thursday, November 19th at 9:00PM (Pacific). Race Day registration is available opens at 7:30am and closes 20 minutes prior to each race category start.

ENTRY FEES: Pre-Registration entry fee is \$25.00 (add \$5 for race day entry) for all CX categories except, Juniors (10-18 yrs) race Junior race for FREE with USA Cycling license, or purchase one-day license for \$10. Juniors must pay regular entry fee for category races if NOT entering Junior race. Additional race entries are just \$5.00/per race after higher entry fee is paid.

A valid USA Cycling license is required for all race participants. Annual USAC licenses can be purchased online at: www.USACycling.org or at registration on race day. Cost for USAC annual license is \$60 (\$30 for Juniors) and expire on 12/31/2009. A 2010 license can be purchased starting 12/1/2009. A One-Day license is available with pre-registration or on race day for \$10. One Day licensed riders are eligible to race CX4 level events at this event only. One Day licensed riders are not eligible for District Championships.

2009 SCNCA Championship Eligibility: Per USAC rules, here are the requirements to enter any SCNCA Championship event:

1. You must have an annual USAC license. You cannot enter with a one-day license, a foreign license, or with a CBR license.
2. You must be a USA Citizen or a Permanent Resident. If your license has an "N" for Citizen, you will be not be able to register for the race.
3. Riders who meet the entry requirements, but live outside the SCNCA territory, can compete but are not eligible for any title, medal, or jersey. The three top spots are reserved for the first three SCNCA riders.

RULES: Event held under USA Cycling Permit. All 2009 USA Cycling and CX rules apply. Event will be held rain or shine, no refunds. Cyclocross and Mountain Bikes (no bar ends) are welcomed. Bike and wheel changes are allowed in the designated pit areas. Riders must wear helmets when on the bike at all times. Riders shall stay on the course or existing trails. Please respect the venue and local residents. No feeds are allowed on course except under discretion of the race officials. Sleeveless jersey/shirts are not allowed.

Warming up on the Course Once the last rider has crossed the line in the current active wave, the officials will allow riders to "pre-ride" the course so they can become familiar with route. Once the next race has started, they need to withdraw from the course before the first rider passes them. There should be enough time for them to complete one lap. As in the past, these riders cannot cross the finish line.

CYCLOCROSS RACING AGE: A rider's racing age for the 2009-10 Cyclocross Season is the 'racing age' they'll be the year of the CX World Championships which take place in January 30-31, 2010. **Your racing age for the entire cyclocross season running September 2009 through January 2010 is based on your age as of 12/31/2010.**

RESULTS: Race results will be posted near the awards area immediately following each race. Please make sure to check your results within the 15 minute posting/protest period or they will be final. Weekly Race Results and Series Standings are posted online at: www.SoCalCross.org
