Registration: Entry fee is \$30 for 20k events and \$25 for 12k events. \$5 discount to current SDBC members. No Mail-in Registration. Online registration at active.com will be open ONLY to Junior's and 'Real' Masters until midnight 9/3. On 9/4, online registration is opened to everyone until sold out. *Juniors and 'Real' Masters beware, this event will sell out!* USCF license required for this event. To qualify for SCNCA Championships riders must hold annual USCF license and must reside in the SCNCA district. Online registration closes at midnight 9/11 or when field limit of 150 is reached. Junior riders remember to have release form signed by parent or guardian. No same day registration for state

championship categories. Same day registration for open categories available, if not sold out. One day and annual USCF licenses will be sold at registration the day of event. Single day licenses are \$10. Event will run rain or shine.

2009 SCNCA Championship Eligibility – Per USAC rules, here are the requirements to enter any SCNCA Championship event:

1. You must have an annual USAC license. You cannot enter with a one-day license, a foreign license, or with a CBR license.
2. You must be a USA Citizen or a Permanent Resident. If your license has an "N" for Citizen, you will be not be able to register for the race.
3. Riders who meet the entry requirements, but live outside the SCNCA territory, can compete but are not eligible for any title, medal, or jersey. The three top spots are reserved for the first three SCNCA riders.

Race Day: Race numbers and USCF licenses are available on race day from 6:00 am to 6:45 am. If you have not signed in by 6:45 am, your number WILL be resold. Bring USCF license. Juniors require parent or guardian signature on release. The event starts promptly at 7:00 am. Riders start every 30 seconds. Start ordered by category and age.

Juniors: This is a Southern California/Nevada ITT Championship event. Riders must hold an annual USCF annual license and reside in the SCNCA district to be eligible for the championship. Riders must register online at active.com to be eligible for state championships. No same day registration for state's medals. Gear limit restrictions strictly enforced (rule 1J6). A preliminary roll-out check will be available near the registration desk. ALL juniors are required to report to roll-out check immediately after crossing the finish line. Failure to report for roll-out check will mean immediate disqualification. Juniors 14 and under will do 3 laps of the island (12K). Juniors 15 and older will do 5 laps (20K). All juniors start and finish at the same location.

Real Masters: This is a Southern California/Nevada ITT Championship event. Riders must hold an annual USCF license and reside in the SCNCA district to be eligible for the championship. Riders must register online at active.com to be eligible for state championships. No same day registration for state's medals. The championship ITT event is open to men 65 and older and women 55 and older. There will be categories for each 5 year age group (65-69 etc). All 'Real' Masters ride 20K (5 laps).

The Course: The short loop around Fiesta Island will be used to accommodate the younger Junior distances. All categories will ride the short loop around Fiesta Island. Fiesta Island is almost flat. There is less than 10 ft of rise per lap. The single lane road is closed to traffic. No vehicles allowed on the island during the event. The 20k course is 5 laps around the island on the short loop. The 12k course for juniors is 3 laps on the short loop. Everyone starts and finishes at the same location. Riders keep track of their laps.

Results and Prizes: Unofficial results will be posted approximately 1/2 hour after the event is over. State championship medals will be awarded to the top three finishers of each state championship category. Fiesta Island medals will be awarded to the top three finishers of each category. SockGuy socks will be awarded to the fastest rider in each category. You must be present to win awards. No medals or socks will be mailed.

Directions: From Interstate I-5, north or south, exit Sea World Drive. Sea World Drive 5 miles north of downtown San Diego. Go west on Sea World Drive to the first signal. Turn right on West Mission Bay Drive and take an immediate left to enter the island. Parking and registration is on the right before you enter the island.
