ENTRIES: Pre-registration is available online at www.SocalReg.com and must be made by April 30, 2009, 11:00PM, PDT. **There will be a \$10 late fee for on-site registration.** Pre-registered riders must sign a release form at race day registration. Riders under 18 must have a parent/legal guardian signature on the release form. Unattached riders (except Men Cat 5 & Women Cat 4) pay an additional \$5 at registration. Additional races are \$10. Entry fee includes \$3 USCF insurance surcharge. All riders must present a valid USCF license at registration. Unlicensed riders may enter Men Cat 5, Master Men 55+, Master Men 60+, and Women Cat 4 races by purchasing a \$10 one-day USA Cycling license at registration. Current USA Cycling National Road Race champions may race free by pre-registering, paying the entry fee, then making a request for reimbursement at race day registration.

RACE DAY REGISTRATION: Registration at Sullivan Middle School opens 1 hour before each race & closes 15 minutes before start. A category with less than a minimum field size of 4 at the close of registration may be combined (along with cash & prizes for that category) and scored separately with another field.

RULES: Race will take place rain or shine. All USA Cycling rules apply. Helmets must be worn while on the bike. The course is open to traffic. Crossing the centerline will result in immediate disqualification. Working with anyone in another race will result in disqualification. Feeding will be allowed only in the designated feed zone just after the Camino del Rey turnaround. Wheel support is provided for Pro/1/2 Men and Pro/1/2 Women only. Wheels in, wheels out. No unauthorized follow vehicles allowed. Held under USA Cycling event permit.

COURSE: A moderately hilly 14.7-mile circuit on well-paved roads. Descend from the start down West Lilac, turn left onto Camino del Rey. Continue to the turn-around at the I-15 underpass. Return to West Lilac and turn right. From there it's ~3.1 miles back to Sullivan Middle School. The finish is in front of the school just before the second turn-around. The last 2.5 miles of the course includes over 400 feet of climbing. Total climbing per lap is approximately 530 feet. Course map available at www.celopacific.org.

DIRECTIONS: **From I-15:** Exit at Old Hwy 395 (between Temecula and Escondido) and travel 1 mile north to West Lilac. Turn left down the hill to Sullivan Middle School. **From I-5:** Exit at Hwy 76 in Oceanside and travel 15 miles east to Old Hwy 395. Turn right (South) 2 miles & turn right on West Lilac to Sullivan Middle School.
