**COURSE:** 9/10 mile, 4 right turns, slight rise and no road dots. The "CBR finish line" on Broadwick St. will be used.

**SOCAL CUP:** 3.0 SoCal Cup points for Masters Champ races.

**MASTERS:** All SCNCA riders eligible for Masters SCNCA Champ. Out of district riders eligible for all other prizes.

**RULES:** USAC governed. Helmets must be worn at all times when on a bicycle. No warm up on race course. Free lap rule in effect. Wheels pit in wheels in, wheels out.

**SPECIAL EVENT GLASS-** 16oz. pub glass to all 114 placers. The glasses are **MADE IN THE USA.**

**REGISTRATION:** Race registration opens 6:30AM. Each race's registration closes 15 minutes before their start. **No one-day licenses sold at race.**

Unattached fee of \$5. Entry fee includes USAC \$3 insurance surcharge. Extra races are \$10 **after paying the highest race fee first.** Late fee of \$7 on day of event. No refunds – race runs rain or shine. Held under USAC permit.

**DIRECTIONS TO COURSE:** From 405 FWY: Take Wilmington North to Charles Willard, turn right. Right again to parking on Broadwick. From 91 FWY: Take Wilmington South to Willard, turn left. Registration at Broadwick and Paulhan.

**Per USAC rules, here are the requirements to enter any SCNCA Championship event:**

1. You must have an annual USAC license. You cannot enter with a one-day license, a foreign license, or with a CBR license.
2. You must be a USA Citizen or a Permanent Resident. If your license has an "N" for Citizen, you will be not be able to register for the race.
3. Riders who meet the entry requirements, but live outside the SCNCA territory, can compete but are not eligible for any title, medal, or jersey. The three top spots are reserved for the first three SCNCA riders.
